The entrance test for January 2026 Session will be conducted at NIMHANS Campus in Bengaluru city only.

C. Additional Information:

- 1. Applicants who are awaiting the results may also appear for the entrance test, subject to production of proof of having passed the examination at the time of Interview.
- 2. In case any candidate/applicant/student is found to have supplied false information or a false certificate or is found to have withheld or concealed some information, he/she shall be debarred from continuing the course and shall face such appropriate action initiated against him/her by the Director of the Institute.
- 3. Selected candidates should submit Transfer Certificate (from the College/Institute where the last eligible qualification is attained) and Migration Certificate (from the University to which the College/Institute is affiliated where the last eligible qualification is attained) at the time of admission.
- 4. The JRF & SRF of candidates selected under 'external fellowship category' at NIMHANS will be activated after joining the Ph.D. course.

- 5. Deputed/Sponsored candidates have to attach 'No Objection Certificate (NOC)' duly signed by their Employer/Parent department along-with the application, failing which application will not be considered.
- 6. Application should be submitted through the Online mode (only) along with all the attachments, signature and photograph through. The link available in website along-with this Notification.
- 7. Application Fee for different categories:

- 8. Admit cards for the entrance test will be sent to applicant's registered Email ID and the candidates have to produce the hardcopy of the same on the day of entrance test.
- 9. All relevant communications regarding January 2026 Session entrance test will be notified in official website from time to time. Any query regarding the same may be addressed to admissions@nimhans.net No other mode of communications will be entertained.
- The decision of the Director of the Institute shall be final in all matters of selection of candidates for admission to the various courses and no appeal shall be entertained on this subject.
- 11. Any dispute in regard to any matter referred to herein shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Bengaluru Courts only.

D. Pattern of entrance test

- 1. The question paper for the Entrance test will contain 100 multiple choice objective type questions.
- 2. The duration of the test for each course will be 90 minutes.
- 3. Each correct answer carries 1 mark.
- 4. There will be negative marking and 0.25 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer.
- 5. No marks will be deducted for unanswered questions.

E. Age Limit:

- I. The age is calculated as on 01.01.2026 for January 2026 Session.
- II. The age limit for Ph.D. courses will be 40 years for External Fellowship Category/Funded by Research Projects of NIMHANS & 42 years for Sponsored /Deputed Candidates and Employees of the NIMHANS.
- III. Age is relaxable by a maximum of 5 years in the case of PwBD candidates (Please check PwBD block under reservation of seats section for more information).
